

Ethical Guidelines of *Revista Estud(i)os sobre Fichte*

Estudos sobre Fichte adheres to the ethical principles established by the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE), committing to academic integrity and editorial quality. All parties involved in the publication process — authors, editors, reviewers, and the editorial team — are expected to observe the following principles:

1. Authors' responsibilities

- Authors must ensure that the submitted work is original, has not been previously published, and is not under review elsewhere.
- All sources and third-party contributions must be properly cited.
- All listed authors must have made significant contributions to the research.
- In case of discovering an error or inaccuracy after publication, authors must promptly notify the editorial team.

2. Peer review

- The journal follows a double-blind peer review system.
- Reviewers must act with impartiality, confidentiality, and respect, providing constructive and well-founded assessments.
- Conflicts of interest must be disclosed to the editorial team.

3. Editorial responsibility

- The editorial team is responsible for deciding which articles to publish, based on academic and ethical criteria.
- Editors must ensure confidentiality in the review process and avoid any conflicts of interest.
- Suspicions of scientific misconduct will be investigated in accordance with COPE guidelines.

4. Publication ethics

- Practices such as plagiarism, data fabrication or manipulation, duplicate submissions, or inappropriate authorship are not tolerated.
- The journal encourages transparency in data and research processes, always respecting applicable ethical standards.
